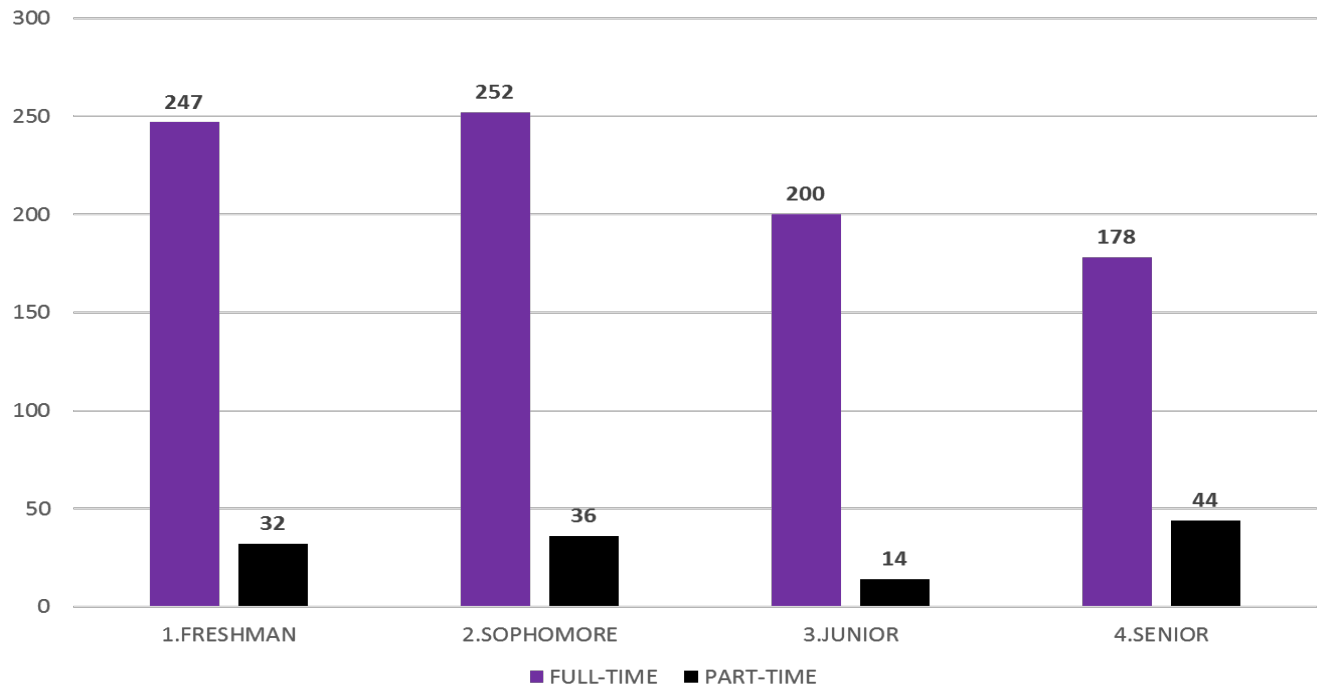
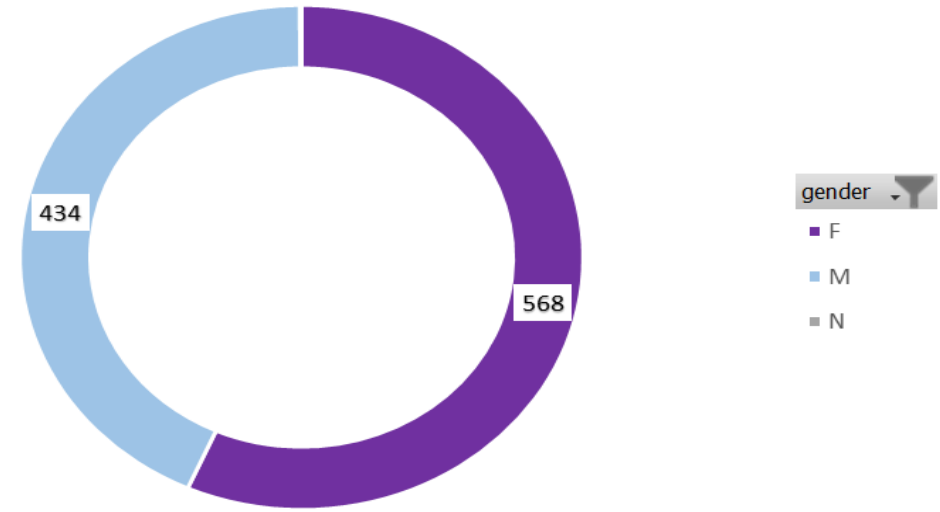


Fall 2018 Census enrollment

Fall 2018 Enrollment Demographics



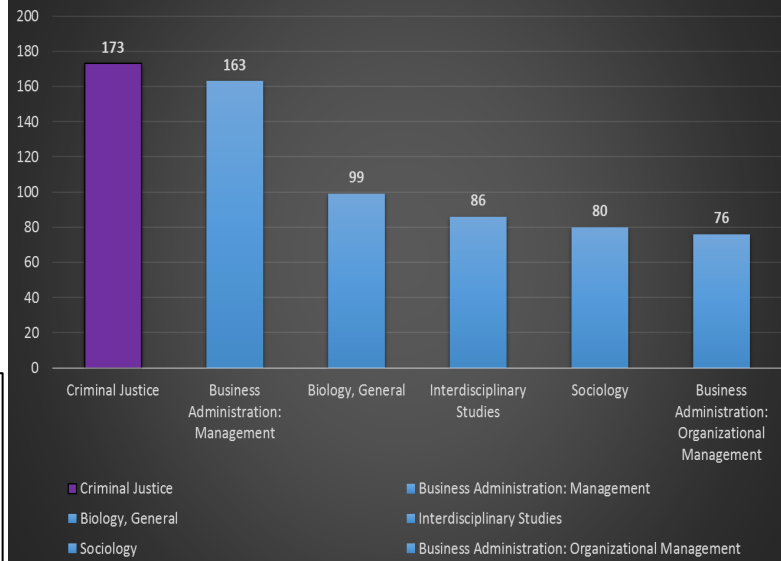

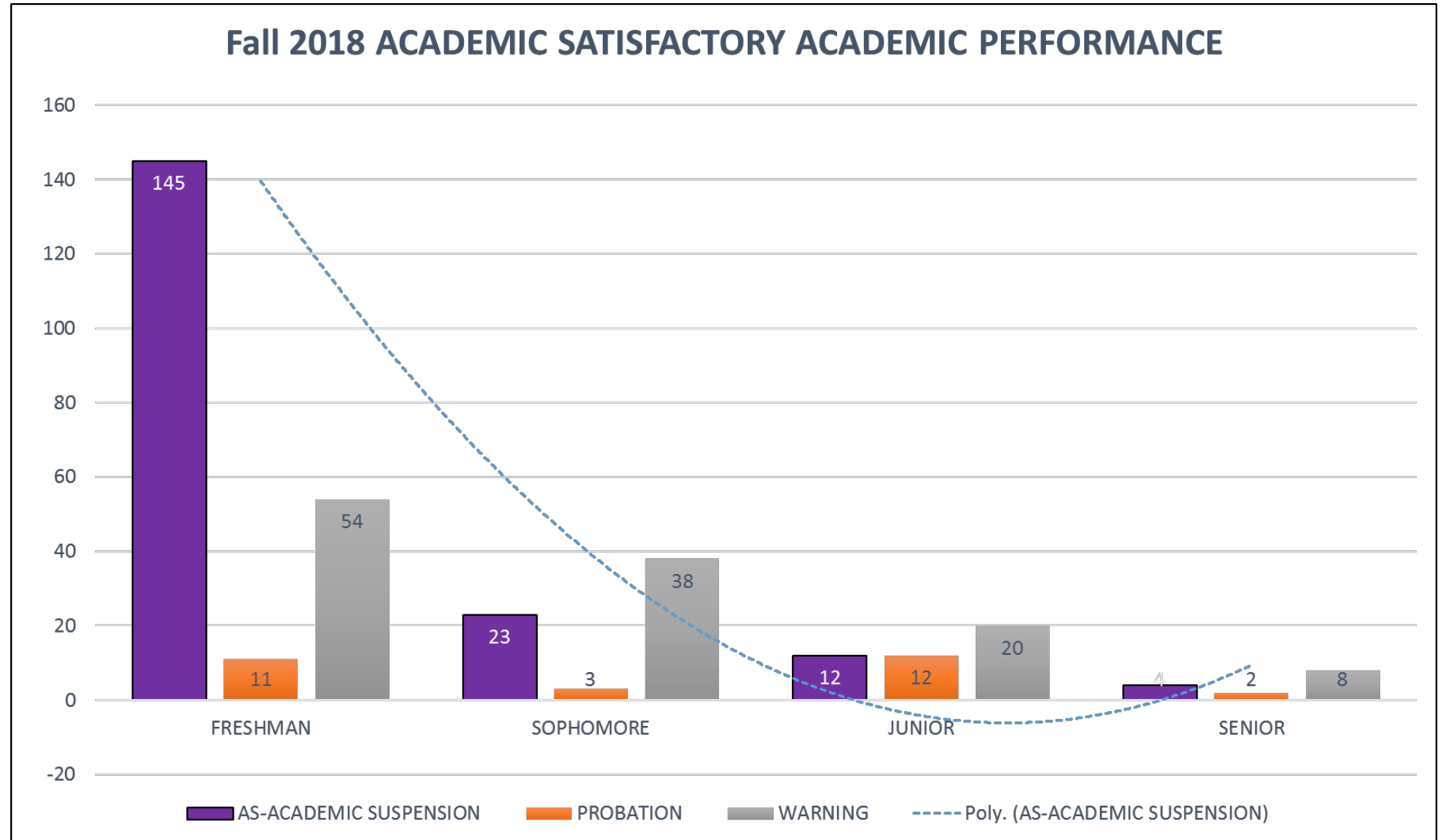

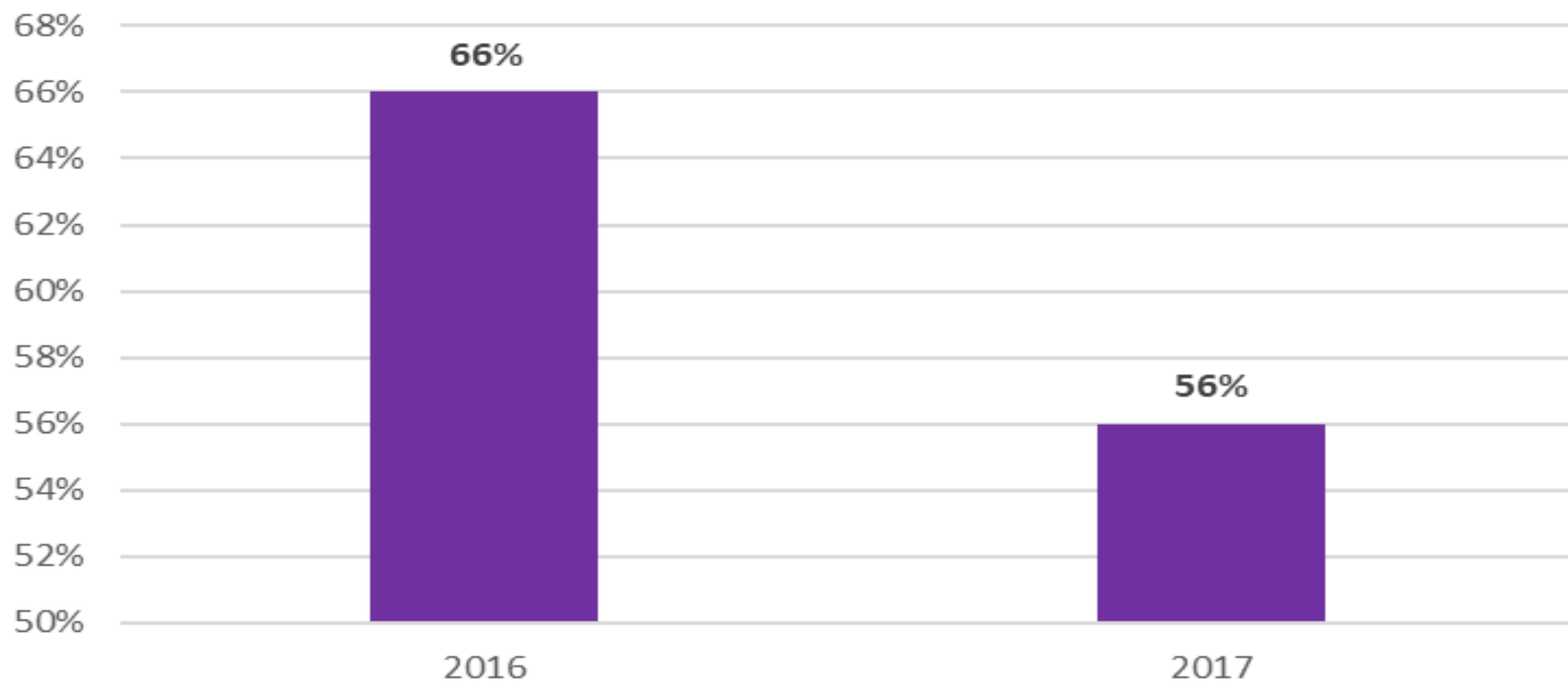

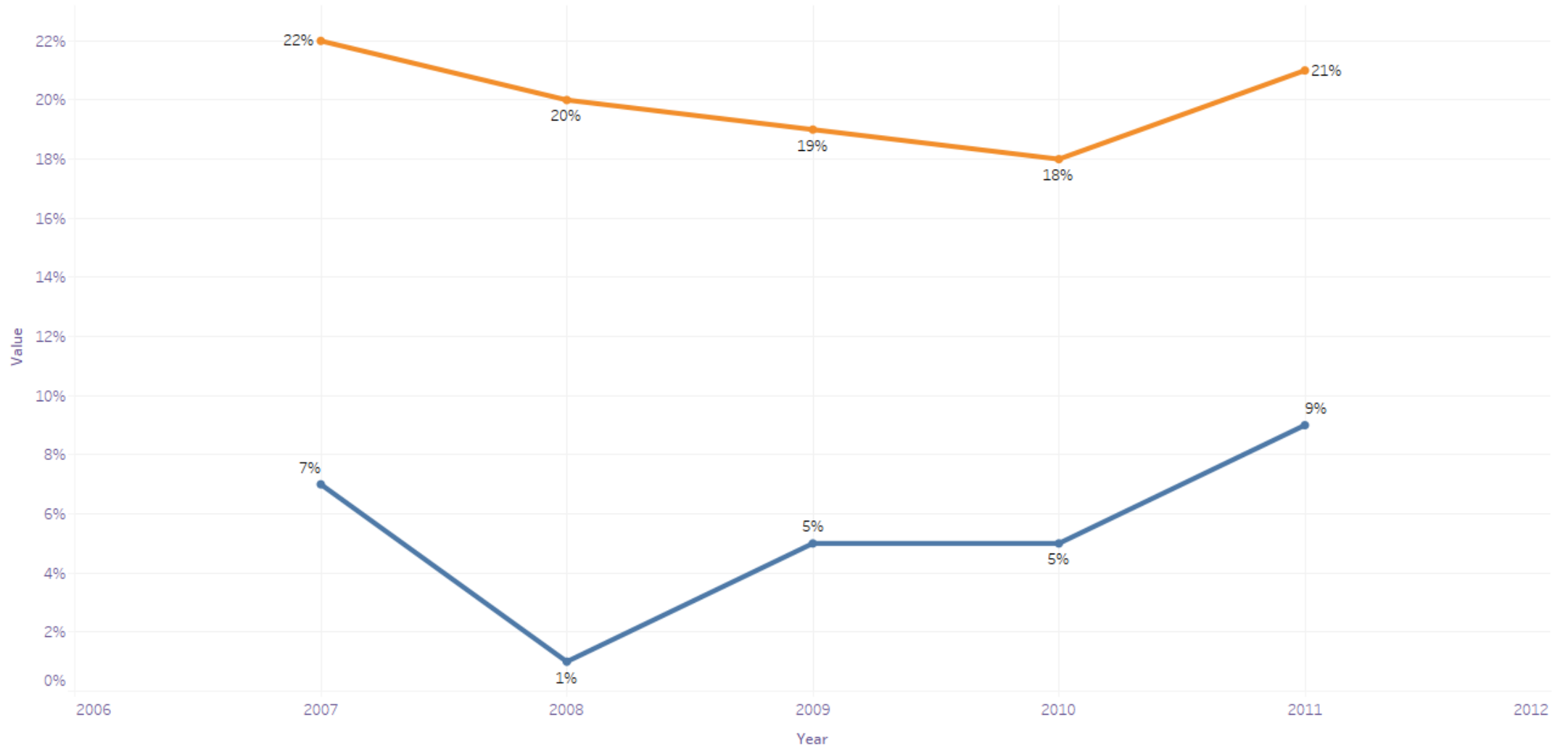
